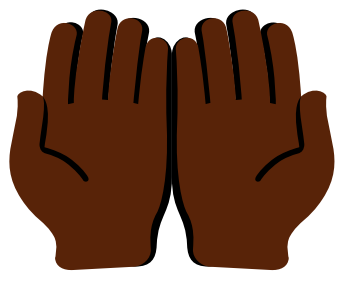

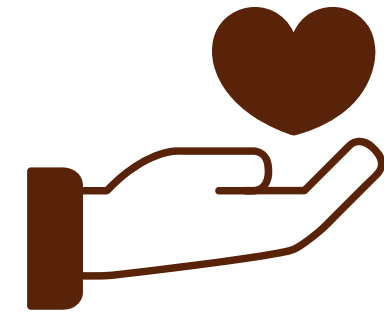

GIVE WHATEVER YOU CAN IN CHARITY.



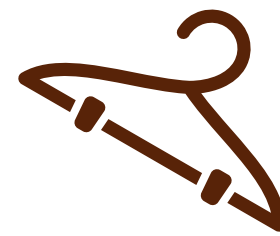
TAKE A BATH BEFORE THE ŞALĀH.



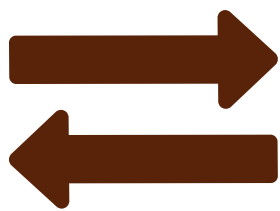
USE A MISWĀK BEFORE THE ŞALĀH.



APPLY 'ITR BEFORE THE ŞALĀH.



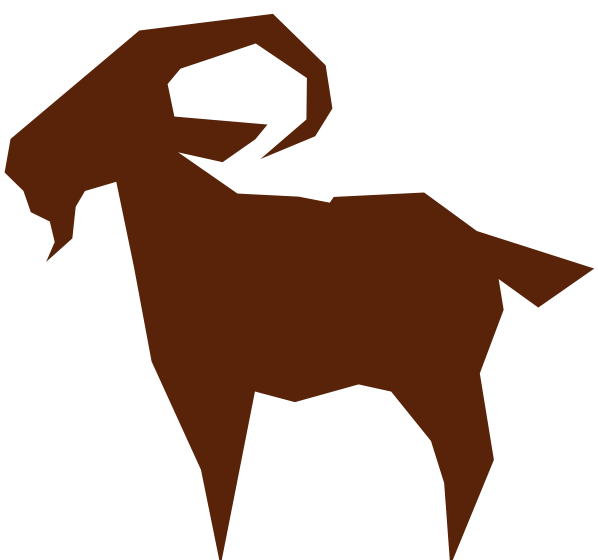
WEAR YOUR BEST CLOTHES (EVEN AT HOME).

SACRIFICE AN ANIMAL

IT IS SUNNAH NOT TO EAT BEFORE EID AL-ADHA SALAH AND IT IS DESIRABLE TO EAT FROM THE MEAT OF THE ANIMALS SLAUGHTERED BEFORE CONSUMING ANYTHING ELSE ON EID AL-ADHA.

EID ṢALĀH: STEP-BY-STEP

Make niyyah for performing two rak'ahs wājib Eid ṣalāh with six additional takbīrs.

First Rak'ah

- 1 Say Allāhu Akbar, fold hands, and recite thanā'.
- 2 Say Allāhu Akbar thrice while raising one's hands each time and then dropping them to one's sides the first two times. One should fold them after the third time.
- 3 Recite the isti'ādhaḥ and basmalah followed by Sūrat al-Fātiḥa and an additional sūrah.
- 4 Go into rukū', and then perform the rest of the first rak'ah as normal.

Second Rak'ah

- 1 Recite Sūrat al-Fātiḥa and another sūrah.
- 2 Say Allāhu Akbar thrice while raising one's hands each time and then dropping them to one's sides.
- 3 Say Allāhu Akbar a fourth time while going into rukū', and perform the rest of the second rak'ah as normal.

KHUTBAH TRANSLATION

First Khutbah

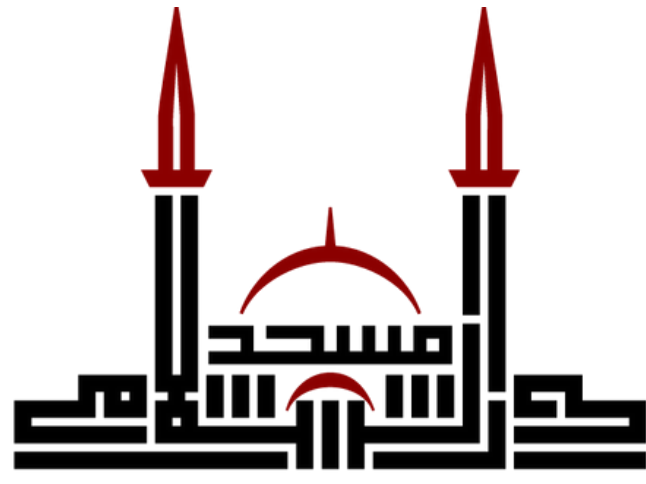
