# Why Understand al-Qur'an - Allah (swt) says:

- ❑ Allah (swt) created the whole universe. He created our Earth in His universe too. Then in this world He created everything including us Humans. He then set up a communication link with Humans through His Chosen Prophets to tell us how we should live here.
- ❑ Allah (swt) sent thousands of Prophets to all regions at various times and their mission was to correct the relationship between Humans and their Creator.
- ❑ Allah (swt) also sent guidance in the form of Books and short instructions. Adam (as) was the first human and prophet of Allah, and our beloved Prophet Muhammad (sas) was His final Messenger who came with His final guidance i.e., "al-Qur'an"

# Why Understand al-Qur'an - Allah (swt) says:

- ❑ The Qur'an is both 'Huda-lin-Naas' & Huda-lil-Mutaqeen. Allah (swt) says about the Qur'an in the Qur'an:
- ❑ Surah al-Baqara, 2:2 - 'This is the Book (the Qur'an), whereof there is no doubt, a guidance to those who are al-Muttaqeen' (the Pious).
- ❑ Surah Yaseen, 36:2 - 'By the Qur'an, 'full of wisdom'
- ❑ Surah Saad, 38:29 - '(This is) a Book (the Qur'an) which We have sent down to you (O Muhammad sas), full of blessings that they may ponder over its Verses, and that people of understanding may remember'
- ❑ Surah al-Qamar, 54:22 - 'And We have indeed made the Qur'an easy to understand and remember, then is there any that will remember (or receive admonition)?'

# Why Understand al-Qur'an – Allah (swt) says

- ❑ Surah al-Ambiya, 21:10 - 'Indeed, We have sent down for you (O mankind) a Book, (the Qur'an) in which there is your Reminder for you. Will you not then understand?'
- ❑ Surah al-Furqan, 25:1 - 'Blessed is He Who sent down the criterion (of right and wrong, i.e. this Qur'an) to His slave (Muhammad (sas)) that he may be a Warner to the universe'.
- ❑ Surah Ibrahim, 14:1 - 'A book which We have revealed to you (Muhammad (sas)) so that you may lead the people from out of the darkness into the light'.
- ❑ Surah al-Isra, 17:9 - 'Verily, this Qur'an guides to that which is most just and right and gives glad tidings to the believers who work deeds of righteousness, that they shall have a great reward (Paradise)'

# Why Understand al-Qur'an - Prophet (sas) said:

**(Ahadith taken from Sahih Bukhari, Sahih Muslim, Tirmidhee and Malik's Muwatta)**

- ❑ **"The** best among you is the one who learns the Qur'an and teaches it."
- ❑ **The Qur'an will** intercede for you on the Day of Judgment.
- ❑ **Your** status in this life will be raised.
- ❑ **There are** ten rewards for each letter you recite **from the Qur'an**.
- ❑ **The** reciters of the Qur'an will be in the company of the noble and obedient and noble angels.

# Our Obligations to the Qur'an

## □ Believe in it

- Belief in the Divine origin of the Qur'an and an attitude of reverence towards it

## □ Read and recite it

- Slow, thoughtful reading of the Qur'an with correct pronunciation (with Tajweed)

## □ Understand it

- Recall through the Qur'an the fundamental truths intuitively recognised by human nature and reflecting over its meaning.

# Our Obligations to the Qur'an

- ❑ **Act upon it**
  - Moulding the personal life of an individual and the collective life of a community according to the teachings of the Qur'an.
  
- ❑ **Convey its message**
  - Propagation of the Qur'anic message and its exposition.
